

- Fruit and vegetable leftovers

- Meat and fish residues
- (small) garden waste (grass, leaves, flowers etc.)
- Not: diapers, ashes, cat litter, paper, hair



Paper and cardboard



- Clean paper (without plastic coatings)
- Cardboard
- <u>Not:</u> greasy pizza boxes, drink cartons



Glass



- Glass bottles (including lid)
- <u>Not:</u> (broken) vases, windows, glassful



Textiles



- Old clothes and shoes (whether damaged or not)
- Curtains, linen, home textiles
- <u>Not:</u> heavily stained, wet, or paint stained textile



Residual waste



- Crisp bags
- Diapers
- Cat litter (non organic)
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- <u>Not:</u> recyclable resources!

What goes in what bin?

PMD



- Food and non-food packaging plastics and plastic foils
- Metal cans (soda, food, etc.) and aluminum foils
- Drink cartons: milk cartons, juice cartons, etc.
- <u>Not:</u> crisp bags, hard plastics (plastic toys, cups, garden furniture etc.)
